

TES allows you to enter sailing events at many clubs and regattas around Australia.

Once you have entered one event, then your boat details (AND uploaded "boat docs") and your details are then available to you to make it very quick and easy to enter another event.

To start an entry

On your computer, smart phone or tablet, go to the nominations link on the RSAYS web site



Select the "Summer 2021-22" link and this will take you to:



To commence an entry click on the "MULTI OR SINGLES SERIES ENTRY" button.

Note: The Casual Entry is only used to enter the next race in a series but its functionality is very similar.

The "MULTI OR SINGLES SERIES ENTRY" button opens a page where you can select which Series / Race you wish to enter.

An example is shown on the next page.


As shown above, there are 3 steps to enter a Series.

But before you can commence your entry you need to establish whether your boat is already stored in the **TopYacht** Boat Registry or not; and, if you are listed as the owner.

Check if your boat is already in TopYacht / if you are registered as the owner.

To check if your boat already exists in the TY Registry please click the link TopYacht Boat Register you can see that twice on the screen under STEP 2 ...




- If your boat exists then proceed as per the next section.
- If the boat has changed owners then contact TopYacht as per the link near the bottom on the entry page (see below).



• If you boat is definitely not there, then use the Enter boat NOT already in TopYacht Boat Register option in Step 2.

Entering a boat ALREADY in TopYacht




As shown above you can either click the Multi Select option to enter a number of Series /Races at the one time, or you can enter a single Series / Race for now and then enter another Series later on, from this same screen.

We will explore the single Series entry first.

Select a single Series that you wish to enter, for example click on the radio button for the Inshore Series





We are assuming you are entering an existing boat, so click that option.



Press SUBMIT at the bottom the page to progress to the Login Page.

Logging in

Enter the boat's sail number and the password of the main contact for that boat. The main point of contact is normally the owner of the boat.

Entering a boat NOT already in TopYacht

STEP 1: Select Series

Select the Series as per the preceding section.

STEP 2: Select an Option

Select the last option ie Enter boat NOT in TopYacht Boat Register



STEP 3: Press Submit

Press SUBMIT at the bottom the page.

Filling in the entry form - intro

Important notes

1. If you are entering a boat that *already existed* in **TopYacht**, then most of the "fields" will be prepopulated with your previously stored information e.g. boat name, sail number, your name etc. This makes the whole process very fast indeed.

If you are entering a **boat NOT already** in **TopYacht**, then you will have to fill in all the fields on the form **for the first Series that you enter.**

2. On the form some fields are marked with an asterix ie a * as circled below.



You MUST complete these fields or you will not be able to submit your entry.

3. The following example is what an entry form looks like for a NEW boat ie there are no prepopulated fields.

Each club seems to want to collect slightly different data. So the example that follows is just one possibility. Other clubs may collect different data.

PREFERRED DIVISION:

Where series are conducted in divisions, select your preferred division. This may be changed at the discretion of the handicap committee.

ENTRY OPTIONS:

Select the handicap divisions that you wish to enter. Where a vessel has a current AMS Certificate, the certificate number, date and rating will be pre-populated.

Entry form – Primary Contact Person details



As the heading says this is for the "Primary Contact Person".

This is the person who receives any correspondence about the boat, has the address for the insurance renewal etc. Normally this is the owner.

Put another way this is the person where the buck stops!

This **MUST** be a real person as explained in the next section; **NOT** "J Small / " and " K Brown" as first and last names of joint owners.

Note: If you do not have an email address then fill in that box with the words "no email address".

Entry form – Joint Owners

Event organisers/clubs require a single, real person as a "Primary Contact Person" for a boat. This is so organisers have a single address to mail club information etc; chase insurance information etc., etc.

l.e. clubs need one nominated person where the buck stops when they (the club/organisers) are sending out or chasing down information for an entry.

The reason is similar to banks, which require a "primary card holder" for a plastic card.

Where there are joint owners this can be easily handled by inputting the details in the Name to display as SKIPPER" section as below.

For example the first name can be input as "J Smith" and last name becomes "/L Brown". You do this as part of the entry.

Just above this part of the form, there is provision for a "Secondary Email" address and an "Additional SMS" mobile so two person's contact details can be recorded to receive any electronic messages from the club

Above is an example of the payment screen for an entry in the Women's Series.

Please note: Whilst it is not compulsory to use the credit card option for payment of entry fees, it will greatly reduce the administrative overhead at the Club if you do so.

Also note that entry into any Series/Race is not valid until payment has been made.

Once you believe that the form is complete, read the Conditions of Entry then tick the

Conditions of Entry box at the bottom of the screen and press the Submit button.


Entry form – Selecting several Series at once-"Multi Select"

The procedure for selecting multiple Series at the one time is the same as entering a single series with the following changes.

1. Select the first option in Step 1 ie




2. On the Entry Page tick EACH of the series/races that you wish to enter.



After making your selection, complete the form following the procedures detailed in the first part of this document.

Entry form - Oops-I have errors!

You have pressed the Submit button but instead of submitting the page it takes you to the top of the page with a list of Errors in red.



The errors tell you want needs fixing

Once these are fixed then pressing the Submit again will result in the entry being accepted.

Entry form – updating an entry

From the entry starting page on the RSAYS website, click on the Multi or Single Series Entry button



On the Enter Series page select the Series in Step 1 as per previously then select the **Update** existing entry details in selected Series in Step 2.




This will take you to the entry page and it will be populated with the data you previously provided.

Now you can make any changes such as crew lists and upload boat documents if you wish.

Entry form - making a casual entry

From the entry starting page on the RSAYS website, click on the Casual Entry button



This will take you to the **Casual Entry** screen which will allow you to make an entry for the **NEXT** race in a selected series. Races available for selection will be updated as the season progresses.

Select the series and then proceed as for a Multi or Single Series entry described earlier.
