1. RULES

The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-24 the prescriptions and Special Regulations Part I of AS Category 6; and any AS amendments; each yacht's class rules except where any of these are altered by the sailing instructions; and by the sailing instructions.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available to registered competitors prior to the event.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at the squadron adjacent to the Sailing Office or via Sailsys.
- 3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to allboats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all trailable monohull yachts and Sports Boats as defined in the AS Special Regulations Part 1.
- 4.2 There are two divisions:

Division 1 Spinnaker Division

Division 2 Non-Spinnaker Division

The organising authority may determine to proceed with only one division and nominate Spinnaker or Non Spinnaker if there are a low number or entrants to the event.

- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter by lodging their Entry via the RSAYS web site (<u>www.rsays.com.au</u>) under the "Regattas" menu.
- 4.4 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees (see 5.1 below).
- 4.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

5. FEES

5.1 The entry fee for the regatta is as follows:

Regatta Entry TSASA members \$50.00; NON-TSASA members \$105 (includes 12 month membership of TSASA)

(Regatta entry includes 3 races)

- 5.2 TSASA Rosebowl ONLY race entry (Sunday only) \$10.00 (entrants must be a financial member of TSASA).
- 5.3 Entries close after 12 April, 2024.

7. TIME LIMIT

For all divisions is.

Race 1: 2 Hours Race 2: 4 hours Race 3: 4 hours

Boats failing to finish within the time limit shall be scored DNF. This changes rule 35.

8. SCORING

PHS Results using Sailsys will be calculated from handicaps determined by the RSAYS Handicap Committee.

TSASA will calculate handicaps for the Rosebowl Race (this is Race 3)

9. COURSES

The TSASA Rosebowl course to be sailed will be taken from the RSAYS & CYCSA Fixed Mark Courses 2023 – 2024 booklet which is available at the Royal South Australian yacht Squadron sailing office or on the website at

https://www.rsays.com.au/wp-content/uploads/2022/09/Inshore-Fixed-MarkCourses-Booklet.pdf or at the discretion of the Race Officer.

10. PROTESTS

Boats intending to protest shall lodge a protest form in accordance with RRS Part 5 within 1 hour of finishing or retiring. In addition, she shall notify the RC boat of her intent, naming the parties involved.

11. PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes for the Regatta (Race 1,2 & 3) will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each division where 6 or more boats participate in that division. 1st and 2nd for 5 boats, 1st only for 4 boats.
- 11.2 The TSASA Rosebowl trophy and race prize for race 3 only available to eligible TSASA members.

12. LIABILITY DISCLAIMER/ INSURANCE

- 12.1 The RSAYS will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.
- 12.2 The RSAYS reserves the right to refuse to accept an entry from any boat.
- 12.3 Attention is drawn to the Fundamental Rules of Part 1 particularly Rule 4: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone'.
- 12.4 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event or equivalent.
